**UNIFORM
POLICY**

Rationale:

- A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of the Dress Code.

Aims:

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

Implementation:

- After consultation, we have developed a Dress Code that we believe provides choice for the students, allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities, and caters for the financial constraints of families.
- The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms will be prescribed, and are required to be worn. The sports uniform is not compulsory.
- For safety reasons, stud earrings and sleepers are worn in the ears only, plus inexpensive watches are the only acceptable jewellery. Piercings are to be in the earlobes only.
- Extreme hair colors (eg: green, pink or purple rinses) and/or extreme hairstyles (eg: spikes or mohawks) and/or extreme coloured contact lenses are not permitted.
- Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics may not be worn at school.
- Sunsmart hats consistent with our Sunsmart policy must be worn outside in terms 1 & 4. Hats are not to be worn inside.
- Where practical students are encouraged to wear close-fitting, wrap-around sunglasses that meet the Australian Standard 1067 (Sunglasses: Category 2, 3 or 4) and cover as much of the eye area as possible.
- The student Dress Code, including details of uniform items will be published in the Wonthaggi North Primary School Information Book.
- School Council requires the Principal be responsible for implementation of the Dress Code in a manner consistent with the Student Code of Conduct.
- Parents seeking exemptions to the Dress Code due to religious beliefs, ethnic or cultural background, student disability, health condition or economic hardship must apply in writing to the Principal for consideration.

Evaluation:

- This policy will be reviewed regularly.
